The beauty and value of these gestures is also incomparable in terms of humanization paths, supported by the help and comfort that comes even from distant countries in this city that has always been a standpoint of mosaic, humus of passion for this art.

The complex made up of valuable works will now remain historical evidence over time and in the hospital spaces, supported by a great artistic, cultural and human value: "Time is an uninterrupted flow, embellished with important stages, where everyone can make own part with the gift of self".

If we observe carefully a mosaic work, we can be attracted by its ability to produce union through its small pieces, to use a parallelism, many stories differently degraded by the colors of the vine, but all always joined together, never divided!

This is the exhortation that hides this art in its own way and this initiative that suggests and invites us to pursue a historical continuity, a continuous and constant dialogue with art which in its own way also knows how to heal the human soul by stimulating the patient in the possible best response to health care or simply inspiring and writing dialogues with society and the territory.

Thanks to the artists who have always been sensitive, willing, and courageous heralds of illumination and renewal in history, even when in spite of itself it is going through dark moments, this project will remain an international symbol, in hospital and citizen life, an expression of solidarity and seriousness flourished from those who have joined, those who have done their utmost to make it happen, and those who feel grateful for the effective and representative value. Thanks to Felice and thanks to each of these artists, who with their hands have united the minds of us all, sealing a constant goal, to safeguard health and the values of life.
